### **From the Seven Habits, and the Seven Pillars of Catholicism:**

We'll take a look at the chapters entitled, "Synergize," and "What Sets Them Apart?"

### **From the Moral Teachings of the Catholic Church:**

This is going to be a whirlwind tour of our Church's teaching!

We'll take a look at the meanings of the concepts: the common good; the dignity, unity, and freedom of the human person; conscience; the natural law; objective and subjective morality.

Do you know why we have them? The research behind them? Even if you, personally, would still disagree, wouldn't you like at least to know for sure what the Church teaches-and why?

2. Your reactions, feelings, thoughts about what you heard? That's all!
