### FOR EVERYONE

...**"To Lead All to Him in the Eucharist..."** This is a time of year when we see one of the practical applications of our mission statement. In most of our parishes, we're celebrating First Holy Communions - the moments when Christians receive Jesus in the Eucharist for the first time. For those of us who have received Him many times, let's remember how important it is to follow the example of our young people: to approach Him with love and reverence, to treat the occasion as a privilege, and to savor the opportunity of being united with our God. What a gift is the Eucharist! Let's never forget that and bring many more people to Him!

**Why is Mary "Queen"?** "Queen Mother" (in Hebrew, *Gebirah*) was a royal title and an office which was bestowed upon the mothers of the Kings of Israel, but limited to those Queens who were mothers of kings in the line of King David. The royal kings of Israel and the House of David had many wives and no single wife of the king had the influence that his mother enjoyed as the chief confidant of her son. It is not clear exactly what position of authority was accorded the mothers of the kings of Israel/ Judah, but scholars believe that Queen mothers of the ruling House of David were crowned, occupied a throne next to their sons, and that both state and religious functions required their presence and attention. Jesus Christ is the heir of King David, He is the fulfillment of the covenant promises made to David in 2 Samuel 7:16; 23:5, and repeated to Mary in Luke 1:26-36. Mary's son rules from the Kingdom of the heavenly Jerusalem. It is fitting that His mother should enjoy the same role that other Davidic Queen mothers enjoyed, that is the royal office of the heavenly "Queen Mother." It is in this sense that Catholics call her "the Queen of Heaven"
